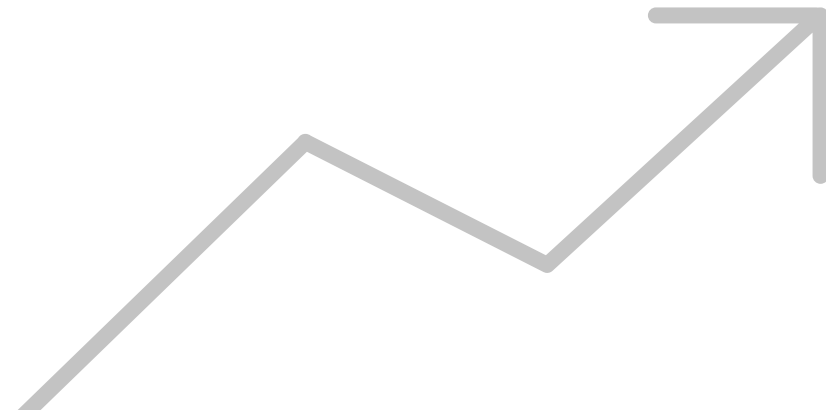

Motivation

- Targeted training of young scientists and future employees already at the universities
- Recruitment of junior scientists
- Data Literacy
- Expansion of cooperation with the scientific community



Targeted training

- Official statistics topics are often only weakly integrated into the curricula; in Germany often better in social science compare to economic science
- Training with real data often does not take place
- The number of chairs at universities dedicated to official statistics or survey methodology is decreasing



Data Literacy

- Working with data and statistics is complex, especially with the micro data products of the Research Data Centers
- decisions in almost all areas of work are based on data and statistics
- as producers of these complex decision bases, we therefore also have a certain responsibility to impart the skills to handle these data and statistics appropriately
